A statement from Founder & Board President, Kari Jo Stefanski:

"We are saddened to have to reschedule Kamp for a Kause. We initially had this event planned for April of 2020 and put it on hold due to the pandemic. Unfortunately, due to a lack of community participation and elements outside of our control, I proposed to the KHYP Board that we move to reschedule Kamp for a Kause to 2024 to be able to make it the best it can be. We are thankful to all those who have registered, sponsored, volunteered, and planned this event thus far.

This postponement comes at a great time of need for not only our organization but for young people who experience adversity in the face of homelessnes in Otsego County. Due to a lack of housing, we are being forced to house 10 young people in local motels alone just this month. This costs our organization \$50/day per young person. We look forward to continuing to serve vulnerable youth in our community."
